## Southern Kentucky Film Commission Film Sponsorship Application



Sponsorships for up to \$2,500 as funding is available.

## **Eligibility:**

Any sponsorships allocated from Southern Kentucky Film Commission (SKFC) will be used solely for approved production expenses (eg. Food, fuel, props, supplies) purchased in the SKFC area for films that have been approved by the Kentucky Film Office in the Kentucky Economic Development Cabinet and are made in the SKFC area (Bardstown, Bowling Green-Warren County, Cave City, Edmonson County, Glasgow-Barren County, Horse Cave/Hart County, Munfordville, Oak Grove/Christian County, Simpson County, and Shelby County). This is a reimbursement program. No money will be given upfront.

## **Procedure:**

- After receipt of the Application (see below) the SKFC board of directors will consider approval of eligibility and amount. The board will notify the applicant of approval or denial within 30 days of the application.
- A Final Report (see below) must be submitted no more than 30 days after the completion of filming in the SKFC area. After verification of the final report and invoices, the sponsorship will be mailed via check to the applicant. Failure to file the report with SKFC in the allotted time frame will result in forfeiture of the sponsorship funding.
- The SKFC logo will appear in the film credits.

**Application**: Southern Kentucky Film Commission requires proof of approval by the Kentucky Film Office and a copy of the script to review before sponsorship approval.
